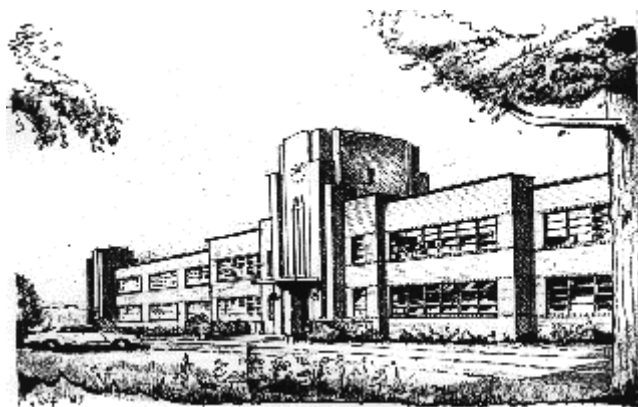

UNIFORM POLICY

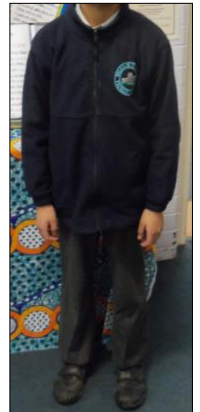

AIMS

The governors of this school believe that a smart school uniform:

- Is not distracting in class (as fashion clothing might be);
- Makes children feel equal to one another in terms of appearance;
- Reflects the sense both of community and of diversity that the school takes pride in;
- Is regarded as suitable, and good value for money, by most parents.



WILLIAM TORBITT SCHOOL UNIFORM

BOYS (Reception - Year 6)

- ✓ **Plain, navy blue** school style jumper / sweatshirt / fleece
- ✓ **White** school shirt / polo shirt
- ✓ **Grey** school trousers
- ✓ **Black** shoes or trainers (any laces must be black)
- ✓ **Plain white, black or navy blue** patka (if worn)
- ✓ **Black, navy blue, dark grey or white** socks



GIRLS (Reception - Year 6)

- ✓ **Plain, navy blue** school style jumper / cardigan / sweatshirt / fleece
- ✓ **White** school shirt / polo shirt
- ✓ **Grey** school trousers / skirt / pinafore dress
- ✓ **Black** shoes, trainers or sensible boots (any laces must be black)
- ✓ **Plain white, black or navy blue** hair accessories or headscarf (if worn)
- ✓ **Blue checked** summer dress (optional)
- ✓ **Black, navy blue, dark grey or white** socks / tights

Sweatshirts / fleeces / polo shirts with the school logo are available from the reception office.

The following are non-uniform items:

- X **Black** sweatshirts / jumpers
- X Hoodies
- X **Blue** shirts
- X T-shirts / polo necks
- X Jogging bottoms / tracksuit bottoms / leggings / fashion trousers / fashion skirts

PE (all children)

- ✓ **Black / navy blue** shorts
- ✓ **White** t-shirt / polo shirt
- ✓ Plimsolls (indoor PE) and trainers (outdoor PE)
- ✓ **Navy blue** sweatshirt and jogging bottoms for cold weather
- ✓ A drawstring bag to keep these items in school
- ✓ Only small stud earrings are permitted; all other jewellery must be removed for PE



Jewellery

- X No jewellery except religious jewellery worn under clothing, a watch, small stud earrings.
- X No nail varnish

Uniform items can be purchased from most high street stores and superstores, eg Sainsburys, Tesco, Asda. Specific items with the school logo on them can be purchased from the school office.

All clothing should be clearly labelled with your child's name. This is especially important as uniform items look similar and can be easily confused for another child's. The school cannot accept responsibility for any lost items.
