Term Topic

Our theme this term is **Once Upon a Time**

We will be looking at different traditional fairy tales such as Little Red Riding Hood, Jack and the Beanstalk, The Gingerbread Man, Goldilocks and The Three Bears. We will also be looking at some newer fairy tales such as The Great Fairy Tale Disaster, The True Story of the Three Little Pigs.



Home Links

As always, we really value the support that you give your children at home. Here are a few ideas that you may want to try:

- Use old cardboard boxes and bits of paper to make a model of your favourite story character.



- You could visit the local library and have a look at the different fairy tale stories they have.
- Encourage your child to cook with you. Talk about the ingredients that you need and what happens to them when they are being cooked.

Reading

Reading is an essential part of your child's day in Nursery and Reception. We have daily phonics sessions, where children learn their sounds. In Reception, we hear the children read their reading books once a week and we visit the library weekly. We will be reading **The Three Little Pigs, Jack and the Beanstalk, The Gingerbread Man, Goldilocks and the Three Bears.**



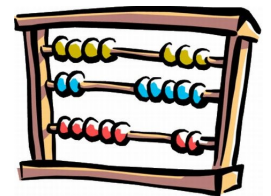
Class Bear

Each class has a special bear which the children have named themselves. A child from each class will have a turn to take the bear home each weekend and bring it back on Monday to share with the class what they have done. The bear will go home with a special book where you can record what the bear does over the weekend with your child and you (e.g. drawings, photos, writing).



Maths

In Maths we will be focusing on 2D / 3D shapes; counting and number recognition; and height, weight, and distance.



School Clothes

Please can you remember to put your child's name in all of their school clothes. As you can imagine, the children get very distressed if they do lose an item of clothing and it is much easier to find it if it is named. If we lend you any clothes, please can you wash them and bring them back to school for other people to use.

Our School Library is available for you to visit with your child

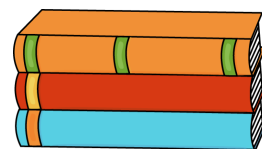


Monday – Friday
