NB THESE ARE NOT KEY WORDS TO BE LEARNT FROM MEMORY-they are just for your child to practise spotting the letter combinations and then sounding out the words. (It may be helpful at first for your child to underline the combinations as well as putting sound buttons under individual letter sounds eg. field, growo.)
