

Follow-up to the 2 and 3 letter combinations flashcards

Words to read by 'spotting' the 2 and 3 letter combinations and sounding them out (It may be helpful at first for your child to underline the combinations as well as the individual letter sounds eg. sweet, toast)

faint	fairy
spark	chunk
clear	sweep
stern	bright
coast	smooth
stood	stork
frown	shift
thump	burst
joint	twang

Longer words to practise sounding out (say the first three sounds and blend them together , then say the next two/ three sounds and blend them together, then finally say the whole word eg. scar – let, scarlet; bam-boo, bamboo; wait-er, waiter)

contain	garlic
chapter	fifteen
serpent	lightning
coaster	toilet
monsoon	cornet
powder	sherbet
thicket	furnish
mustang	appear
